

PROJECT SHAISHAV ACTIVITY REPORT FROM DECEMBER,2023 TO FEBRUARY,2024.



TASK 1

To regularize all the children who are enrolled in the Anganwadi center.

Previous status: Only 7 children were coming regularly to the Anganwadi.

Progress made: Total 12 to 16 students have started coming to the center regularly.

TASK 2

To follow official timing of the Anganwadi center as per ICDS department.

Previous status: Children reach the Anganwadi center at 11:30 am and leave at 12:15 pm daily.

Progress made: Children reach at 10:30 am & stay till 01:00 pm daily.



TASK 3

To ensure Anganwadi worker follows the yearly syllabus of ICDS department.

Previous status: Yearly syllabus was not being followed.

Progress made: Anganwadi worker daily refers the syllabus and comes prepared to implement the same.

TASK 4

To inculcate habits such as: Organizing slippers in a line, wishing good morning, Hand wash & Prayer.

Previous status: Only hand wash was done regularly & Prayer was done sometimes.

Progress made: Children are daily encouraged to follow all the above habits

TASK 5

To motivate the staff to pick-up all the enrolled irregular children from their home.

Previous status: Children staying near the AWC came regularly.

Progress made: Helperben has started visiting sometimes to pick-up children who stay afar from the AWC or she calls their parents and asks to send the kid.

TASK 6

To lessen intake of food packets/ padikas

Previous status: All the children daily used to consume 4 to 5 packets of wafers/ biscuits and didn't eat cooked meals at Anganwadi or home.

Progress made: Some children have stopped eating wafers and started eating cooked food in AWC & their home whereas some children consume only few packets of padikas.

TASK 7:

Making parents aware regarding sending their children regularly to the AWC

Previous status: Parents weren't sensitive towards education of pre-school hence, only 6 to 7 children were regular.

Progress made: Parents were convinced by MF team to send their children regularly to the Anganwadi resulting in presence of 12 to 17 children daily.

TASK 8:

Creating Goodwill of Mulya Foundation among mothers & community.

Previous status: Parents weren't confident to send their children regularly to the Anganwadi because, of poor quality of education.

Progress made: Parents started sending their children on a regular basis after Mulya Foundation started supporting the staff of ICDS department to fill the gaps in education system by implementing Project Shaishav.

Funds utilized by Mulya Foundation from June, 2023 to February, 2024:

June to November, 2023 – Developing base of Mulya Foundation (visiting various anganwadi centers of Old Padra taluka, meeting authorities of Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) department, visiting all the Anganwadi centers of Jaspur village & selecting the one which was in dire need, orientation visits, undergoing training to develop Teaching Learning Materials under "Project Shaishav" at grass root level, developing website, logo & social media handles (instagram, facebook & youtube) of Mulya Foundation & communicating with public & corporate etc.

December,2023 to February,2024 – Regular field visits, updating social media handles, updating website, need assessment survey, baseline survey, **h**ouse hold visits of the beneficiaries, making TLM's, making daily reports etc.
